Non-Agenda Items: None.

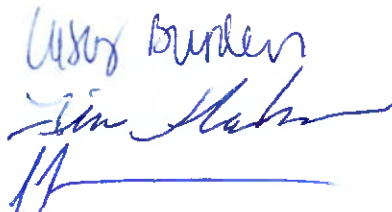
